Blue Sunday at the House of Praise was a success. I gave out 2 planters that I had, all the pinwheels, and all the flyers and Julie S business cards.

There were about 10 flyers & Business cards left; I left that in our Welcome Center counter. Many people came up to talk and ask questions; some are already enrolled and waiting placement (first time foster parents whom are very excited) and I had someone sign up for contact.

Blue Sunday at Cathedral of Praise was a success. We had several people showing interest and a few signed up to be phoned with more info. We displayed two pin-wheel planters, which will remain on display until next Sunday. Between morning worship service and night service, managed to give out all 50 of our flyers. We also handed out a few seed pod book marks and several "Learn More" business cards. I'm pretty confident that there will be a positive outcome. Thanks, Stephanie Bragg, for helping me out, I really appreciated your being there, as you were able to answer questions that I wouldn't have been able to. Blessings to you.

I took 200 flyers and some bookmarks to St. Patrick Church in Wellington. All of the bookmarks were gone before I even got there and many of the flyers were taken as well.

They were displayed next to the bulletins at all church entrances. I left the remaining flyers.

Blue Sunday at Sacred Heart Chapel was a blast! I spoke after each service about the need for foster parents in our community and the different levels of commitment. The information was well received and I had a lot of people come to my table after each service. Some people waited for me to finish to ask questions. I had a total of 13 good prospects! Bam! :) Of course, I took a planter with pinwheels and the planter will be displayed until next Saturday. I am very encouraged and hope these names convert into certified foster homes for our children!
