PARKING INSTRUCTIONS For classes held at the: Lorain County Administration Building, 226 Middle Avenue in Elyria

Park in the garage directly behind the Administration Building (access to the parking facility is off of Third Street). When entering the garage from 3rd street park in any parking space. Entrance into the building will only be available at the lower level parking garage door, as all other doors will be locked. Someone will be at the door to let you in (usually 15 min. before and until 5 min. after class begins) and direct you to the room location.
