Ashley is a talkative and busy girl. She likes to swim and play outside. Ashley loves toy ponies and the color pink! She especially likes to draw with pencil and paper. She really enjoys having the attention of her care givers. Ashley has speech and social delays that are being addressed at school through an Individualized Education Plan (IEP). She is not performing on level with her classmates at this time. Ashley is currently taking medication for symptoms of ADHD to assist her ability to focus while in school and at home.

Both Allison and Ashley will need a family with lots of energy and patience who can advocate for them, provide strong structure with clear limits and set appropriate boundaries. Their adoptive family will need to give the girls a great deal of nurturing and look forward to challenging the girls to reach their potential in all areas of their lives. They will need to be willing to follow through with and be supportive of the therapeutic interventions currently in place as well as those needed in the future.
