Anna needs a family that has the time to devote one-on-one attention and is willing to advocate for her in all areas. Anna's new family must be willing to work with service providers in order to learn more about her and how to care for her specific needs.

Professionals working with Anna recommend that she not have contact with her birth family, although she still cares for them. Although Anna has siblings who are in the care of relatives, she will not have contact with them at this time.
