She is working on thinking before she acts as well as admitting when she has not made the best decision. Anna needs parents who will help her in her development of healthy personal boundaries. She also needs parents who will embrace her as part of the family, giving her the stability and security of belonging.

Anna needs a family! Because Anna has been waiting for a family and wants the attention that parents give, it would be best there were no other children in the home close in age to Anna. Younger children in a family may be a source of insecurity for Anna however older, more independent children in the home might be more comfortable for Anna. Like any child, Anna needs parents who are committed to advocating for what she needs. Anna's parents will need to work with service providers in order to learn more about her and how to care for her specific needs.

Currently there are no birth family members whom contact with at this time would be in Anna's best interest.
