Kinship Care

About Us

Kindship Care is an initiative by the State of Ohio to actively address the needs of our older citizens or other relatives who may be rising a grandchild or other relative.

In 1998, the University of Cincinnati was commissioned by the State to perform a needs assessment of grandparents and other relative caregivers. Their findings indicated that grandparents are actively involved in raising grandchildren in 10% of households with children. One out of four of these households, had grandparents as sole providers and the numbers are growing.



You are not alone

If you or someone you know has taken on the responsibilities of raising a grandchild or other relative, our Kinship program is here to assist the best way we can.



Types of Caregivers:

<u>Custodial</u>-Legal custody is granted. The caregiver takes on responsibility of daily care with sole responsibility for the care of the child(ren).

Living With-The parent lives with the child. The caregiver is there for economic and emotional support without legal recourse in determining what is best for the child.

<u>Daycare</u>-This is the more traditional role where the grandparent provides routing care, and the child does not reside in the caregiver's household.
